NEW SYSTEM OF ASSESSMENT AND EXAMINATION
FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2017-18 ONWARDS

CBSE has remodelled Assessment Structure and Examination pattern from Academic Session 2017-18 onwards. The New System for classes 6th to 8th has been designed on Term Assessment basis with gradual increase in the learning assessment as the students move forward. This would prepare the students to cover the whole syllabus in classes IX & X Board Examination.

The new criteria of Examination under **Scholastic Area** for classes 6th to 8th will be as follows (as per instructions by DAV Board, New Delhi):

For classes 6th to 8th

TERM 1: (100 Marks)

1. Periodic/Unit Test = 8 marks
2. Note Books = 4 marks
3. Project/Activity = 4 marks
4. Subject Enrichment = 4 marks
5. Half Yearly Exams = 80 Marks

TERM 2: (100 Marks)

1. Periodic/Unit Test = 8 marks
2. NoteBooks = 4 marks
3. Project/Activity = 4 marks
4. Subject Enrichment = 4 marks
5. Final Exams = 80 marks

Syllabus for Final Examination (for each subject)

For Class 6th → 10% of 1st Term & entire syllabus of 2nd Term

For Class 7th → 20% of 1st Term & entire syllabus of 2nd Term

For Class 8th → 25% of Term-I & II entire syllabus of 2nd Term

For classes 9th & 10th

With restoration of class 10th Board Examination w.e.f. academic year 2017-18, the assessment structure and examination pattern for class 9th & 10th will be similar as follows :

Full Academic Year (100 Marks)

1. Periodic Test =10 Marks (best two to be taken out of 3 Tests in academic year)
2. Note Books = 5 Marks
3. Subject Enrichment = 5 Marks
4. Annual Examination =80 Marks

For Class 9th & 10th: Entire Syllabus covered in Academic Year.

Co-Scholastic Areas

Classes 6th to 8th

Activities like Work Education, Art Education, Health and Physical Education and Discipline will be graded Term-wise (I and II each) on a 3 point (A-C) grading scale.

Classes 9th to 10th

Activities like Work Education, Art Education, Health and Physical Education and Discipline will be graded in the end of year on 5 point (A to E) grading scale.
